

Evening Study Guidelines

Dear Parent / Guardian,

As you may be aware the school offers the service of supervised evening study. We have found over the years that study is of huge benefit to the students who participate.

A new term of evening study commenced on Monday 9th January 2012 and will run until the 25th May 2012.

We would like to take this opportunity to encourage all students to consider availing of this service. **We would particularly encourage 3rd and 6th year students to consider attending.** This is an extremely important year for them with mock and state examinations forthcoming. Therefore, supervised evening study would be considered particularly beneficial. Students will benefit from working in an environment that is focused, orderly and ultimately conducive to effective study.

Your daughter's attendance at evening study is recorded in her journal on a daily basis. Coupled with this students must **swipe in** to evening study prior to its commencement each day. This procedure allows for very close monitoring of attendance.

EVENING STUDY PRICES

The cost of evening study for the period running from 9th January 2012 until 24th May 2012 will be as follows:

4.15 p.m. - 6.15 p.m. - TWO HOUR SESSION

(Please note there is a 10 % discount for sisters attending.)

Payments will be received during the week of 16th-20th January. We would ask that students make payments in an envelope, clearly labeled with their name and class. A receipt confirming payment will be given to your daughter. **It is important to highlight the excellent value of supervised evening study in our school, at an average cost of €1.35 (1 ½ hrs) or €1.80 (2 hrs) a session.**

We ask that you and your daughter read the rules for evening study in the school journal before signing them. This should be presented upon payment.
