The school subsidises the Study Clix payment. Journals will only be given to students upon verification of payment on the first day back to school. Payment can be made using "Easypayments Plus", the online payment system. Log onto www.loretobalbriggan.ie and click the Easypay icon. Please bring receipt or receipt number to the school on the first day.

First instalment €80 must be paid prior to reopening. Balance will be taken automatically in 4 monthly payments from date of 1st payment. There is also an option to pay the fee in full.
